- a) Full size inserts: supplied untrimmed, printed, folded (except single leaf), and ready for binding. Varnished inserts are acceptable at the Publisher's discretion.
- b) A-size: Supply size: 8\%" x 11" pre-trimmed on head and face. \%" foot and gutter grind.
- 4. **Trimming:** Trimming of oversized inserts will be charged at cost. Keep live matter ½" from trim edges and ¾6" from gutter trim. Inserts are joqqed to the foot. Book trims ¼" at head face and foot.
- 5. BRCs:
 - a) Pricing: When accompanied by a minimum of an island/half page, a tip-in fee of \$850 is charged; non-commissionable.
 - b) BRC Specifications: 3½" x 5" minimum to 4¼" x 6" maximum; perforated with ½" lip (from perforation) for binding. Add ½" for foot trim. Cardstock minimum: 75# bulk or higher.
- Quantity: Full run 23,000 (estimated). Exact quantity will be given upon Publisher's approval of insert or call Publisher prior to closing date.
- 7. Shipping: Carton packing must have publication name, issue date, and insert quantity clearly marked. Inserts shipped in e-containers cannot be verified and Healio Strategic Solutions will not be responsible for shortages on press. Make sure all pieces are oriented the same way in the carton (all facing the same direction). Do not include slip sheets in between pieces or shrink wrap in bundles.
